



The Biggest Bubble Challenge

Collect a few different items that you think will create good bubbles. Shoe laces, small hoops even just making a circle with your hands or fingers will work well, see what object in your house works the best.

HOW TO MAKE BUBBLES

Find a large container, a washing up bowl or a bucket is ideal. To make bubble mix combine:

- * 1 Teaspoon of sugar
- * 4 cups of cold water
- * 2 table spoons of washing up liquid

Give everything a good mix if you are struggling try adding some more washing up liquid to the mixture.

Challenges

1. Place your item in the water and see if you can create the largest bubble. You might need to experiment with the different objects that you have.
2. See how many bubbles you can create in 1 minute, challenge yourself to beat your own score or play this challenge against someone else.
3. How long can you keep a bubble in the air for? This might be tricky on a windy day but without touching the bubble with your hands or an object try to keep the bubble floating in the air for as long as you can. You can time yourself or challenge others to see who can keep it in the air for the longest.
4. Get creative. Create a course that you can guide your Bubble around. Start off small by trying to move your bubble 5 steps away, then start to add on more challenges like turns or add a hoop to guide your bubble through. You could even make a small race track to race your Bubble around.
