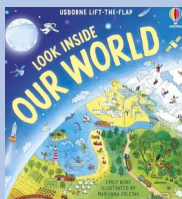
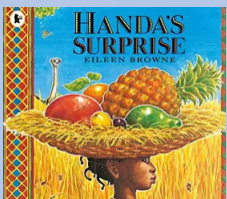




# Reception Learning Overview – Summer Two

# Prime Areas of Learning



## Communication and Language

**We will:** be developing our vocabulary through exploring a range of fiction and non-fiction books. The children will begin to discuss the difference between where they live and other places around the world. The children will be able to talk about modes of transport and journeys that they have been on.

**We will learn:**

# Specific Areas Of Learning

## Literacy

**In reading we will learn:** to retell stories using our own words and recently introduced vocabulary.  
**In writing we will learn:** Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others, attempting a capital letter, finger space and full stop.  
Form most letters correctly.

## Mathematics

**We will learn:** about doubling and halving. We will share and group objects.  
We will also explore even and odd numbers.  
We will deepen our understanding patterns and relationships.

## Understanding The World

**We will learn:** about ways in which we can travel to explore the world. We will understand that our planet consists of land and water. We will learn about food from other countries as well as which animals we will find in hot and cold countries. We will begin to understand why litter is harmful to the planet and ways in which we could help look after our world.

## Expressive Arts and Design

**We will learn:** to select appropriate materials when constructing and making different habitats and flags. We will describe what, why and how something was made and compare with others.  
Use sticks, logs, and stones as instruments to explore rhythms from around the world.
